



### Project objective:

Implementation of a candid and not limited by the ideology of a particular party dialogue between representatives of small and medium-sized businesses in Germany and Russia, as well as representatives of the state government and the expert community in order to present the actual state of affairs in the SME sector in Germany and Russia. The dialogue helps to form an impression of the prospects of the Russian market for German business, and of the German market for Russian business.

### Project description:

Within the framework of the project, a series of German-Russian conferences for SMEs is being prepared and held with the aim of intensifying bilateral economic cooperation, balanced and unbiased presentation of investment opportunities of Russia, municipal, regional and federal programs and support tools for foreign investors, as well as local business patterns. Project description:

Preparing and holding a series of training seminars on the internal and external policy of the Russian Federation for young professionals from Germany: experts on Eastern Europe, young politicians, scientists and journalists. The project allows them to form an objective opinion on Russian politics, invites them to an open dialogue with representatives of the Russian state government, as well as the scientific and expert community. In the context of the growing media war between Russia and the West, the project presents a unique opportunity for direct, frank and unbiased dialogue for decision-makers in Russia, and young representatives of the German elite. As part of training seminars, young German specialists visit the Russian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Defense, the Ministry of Economic Development, the State Duma, the Federation Council, the Public Chamber of Russia, the Presidential Administration, the Russian Academy of Sciences, as well as Russian «think tanks».

Monitoring has been carried out through a network of our own correspondents in 8 countries of the former Soviet Union. The practical result of the project is a number of informational and analytical products supplied on a contractual basis, as well as on the basis of cooperation agreements with our clients and partners, including research organizations, public and political structures.

## STRATEGIC DIALOGUE RUSSIA-GERMANY

Project launched – 2019 год

### Project objective:

Formation of a highly professional group of experts on a wide range of international and regional problems, capable of prompt and confidential discussion of the most sensitive issues in relations between Russia (and the post-Soviet space) and Germany (including the EU context), exchange of reliable information that can become a natural barrier within the increased information activity of both countries.



### Project description:

The Track II diplomacy direction of our Center is represented by the project of the Russian-European expert strategic dialogue "Russia-Germany", which became the reaction of the Russian and European expert communities to the escalation of the geopolitical confrontation between Russia and the West.

The project aims at creation of an expert system for the exchange of information in order to reduce the general tension in the region and to form, on the one hand, a system of trust between East and West, and on the other hand, a phased plan for breaking the deadlock in Russian-Western relations. The expert nature of the network that is being built is a natural filter against annoying and meaningless propaganda and also unverified and unreliable information, which initially provides special attention to the results of the expert dialogue of both political classes and the leadership of countries, as well as military-strategic blocs and alliances.
